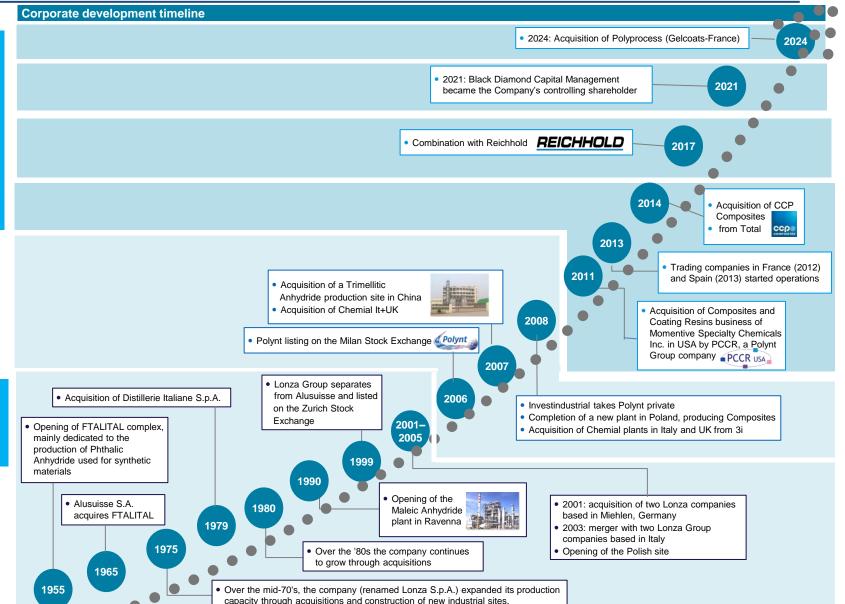

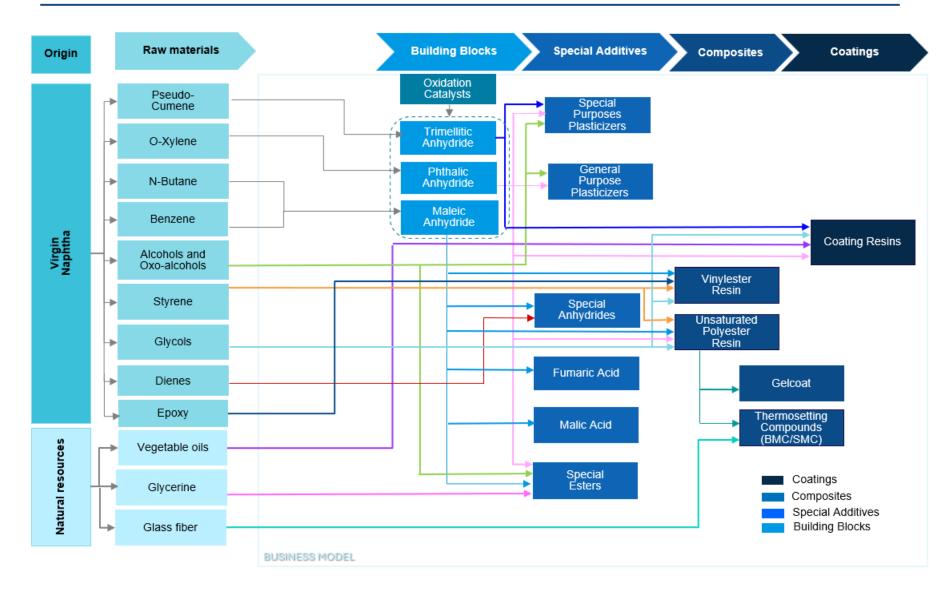

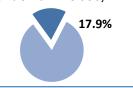

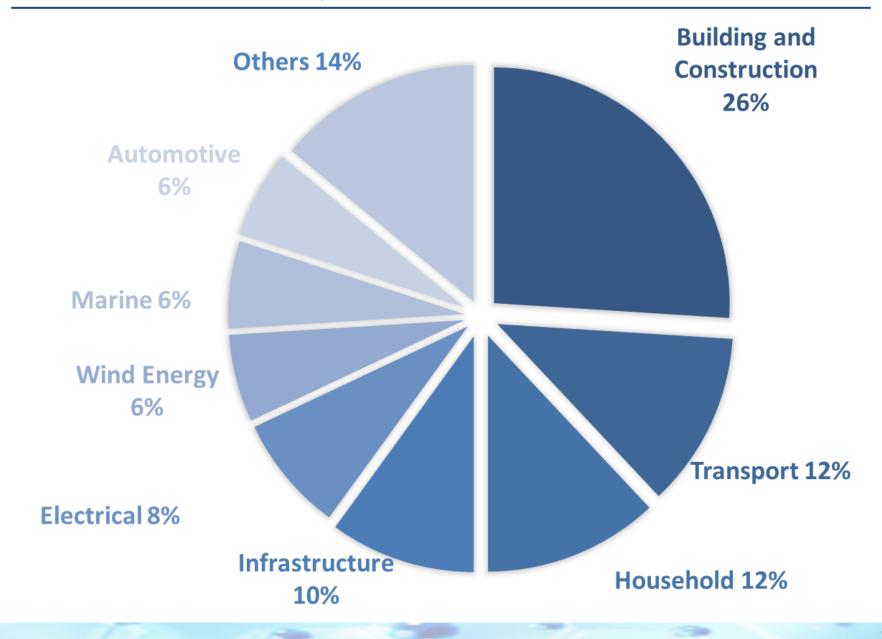

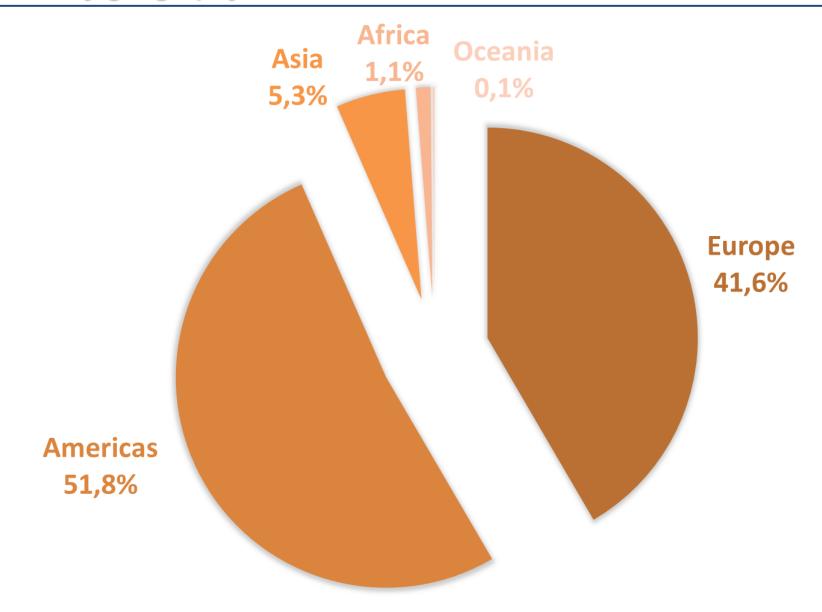
Revenues breakdown by end market





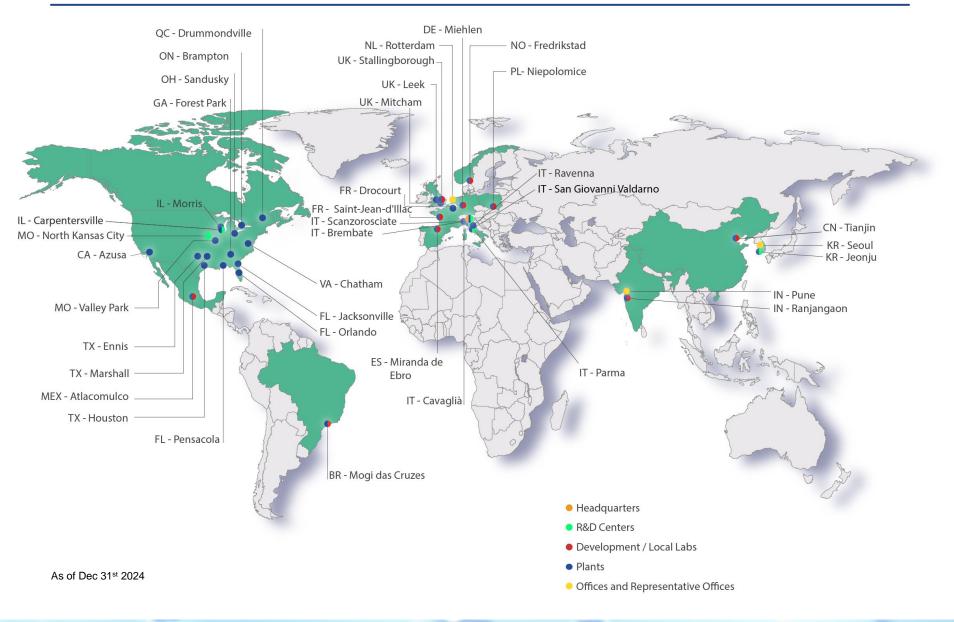
Sales by geography
